Performance and Analysis

Business Performance Summary

Revenue

The Group's operating revenue comprises:

- (1) Sales income from electricity generated by solar power plants owned by the Group's subsidiaries; and
- (2) Service and rental income, which includes site procurement and related services provided across 17 solar power projects.

For the nine-month period ended 30 September 2025, the Group reported total revenue of THB 56.57 million, an increase of THB 1.77 million or 3.22% from the same period of the previous year (THB 54.80 million). The increase was primarily driven by higher electricity sales resulting from stronger solar irradiation during the period.

Net profit (loss)

For the nine-month period ended 30 September 2025, the Group recorded a net loss of THB 11.09 million, a decline of THB 21.64 million or 205.13%, compared with a net profit of THB 10.55 million in the previous year. The loss was mainly attributable to the expected credit loss provision for trade receivables recognized in the separate financial statements.

Quarter-on-quarter (QoQ), net profit rose 108.87%, improving from a net loss of THB 20.55 million to a net profit of THB 1.82 million, primarily due to the expected credit loss provision recorded in the second quarter of 2025 as noted above. Year-on-year (YoY), net profit increased 15.49%, from THB 1.58 million to THB 1.82 million, driven mainly by higher electricity sales.

Kev Milestones

The Company or SAAM was established in 2007 to provide site procurement and related services for solar power plant projects. The Company subsequently **expanded** its business scope to cover the development of solar power plant projects, investments in solar power projects, and the development of renewable energy projects overseas.


In 2022, the Company broadened its scope beyond its original role as a "Project Developer" in the energy sector by diversifying into non-energy businesses, beginning with investments in the gaming industry as a "Game Project Developer". This expansion included developing proprietary games for commercial distribution as well as co-developing games with other companies. In 2025, the Company further extended its business into Digital Platforms and the Digital Economy.


Risk Management Policy
